Enrollment Update

We currently are at capacity in grade K and have small waitlists in grades 1-5, and we have 2 openings for grade 6. Parents, even though we have waitlists, there is still a strong possibility that new applications we receive will be able to attend in the fall. In a typical year, around 90% of students enrolled actually come on the first day. Many of the parents on the waitlist have been there since before the summer and may have selected another school. With that, parent recommendation accounts for nearly all of our growth! If you know parents looking for a great school, please have them apply!!

We are very excited about our growth in enrollment and the amazing new staff members who will be joining us for the 2023-24 school year! Students Walking or Riding a Bike to School
